

Architectural drawings of window and door details for the second floor finished floor. The drawings include:

- S5** (Ground Floor Finished Floor): A window with a total width of 21'-0" and a height of 9'-8". It features a small side pane (6'-2" wide) and a main double-pane section (13'-0" wide). The main section has two panes, each 8'-0" wide, with 6'-5" of space between them. The side pane is 6'-5" high. The main section is 8'-0" high. The side pane is 6'-2" wide. The main section is 13'-0" wide. The total width is 21'-0".
- S6** (Ground Floor Finished Floor): A square window with a width of 6'-7" and a height of 8'-0".
- S7** (Ground Floor Finished Floor): A window with a total width of 11'-11 1/2" and a height of 10'-0". It features a double-pane section with two panes, each 5'-8" wide, with 5'-8" of space between them. The total width is 11'-11 1/2".
- S11** (Second Floor Finished Floor): A window with a total width of 15'-0" and a height of 8'-8". It features a double-pane section with two panes, each 8'-0" wide, with 6'-5" of space between them. The total width is 15'-0".
- S12** (Second Floor Finished Floor): A square window with a width of 6'-9" and a height of 9'-8".
- S13** (Second Floor Finished Floor): A window with a total width of 8'-0" and a height of 9'-0". It features a double-pane section with two panes, each 4'-0" wide, with 4'-0" of space between them. The total width is 8'-0".
- S19** (Second Floor Finished Floor): A small rectangular window with a width of 4'-0" and a height of 2'-0".
- S20** (Second Floor Finished Floor): A window with a total width of 10'-0" and a height of 4'-0". It features a double-pane section with two panes, each 4'-0" wide, with 4'-0" of space between them. The total width is 10'-0".
- S21** (Second Floor Finished Floor): A narrow vertical window with a width of 2'-0" and a height of 8'-0".
- S24** (Second Floor Finished Floor): A narrow horizontal window with a width of 9'-7" and a height of 2'-0".
- S25** (Second Floor Finished Floor): A square window with a width of 5'-6" and a height of 7'-0".
- W1** (Second Floor Finished Floor): A window with a total width of 3'-0" and a height of 10'-0". It features a double-pane section with two panes, each 3'-0" wide, with 3'-0" of space between them. The total width is 3'-0".
- IS1** (Second Floor Finished Floor): A narrow vertical window with a width of 3'-8" and a height of 9'-0".

1. EXTERIOR WINDOWS SHALL BE IMPACT GLASS WITH HIGH VELOCITY HURRICANE ZONE PRODUCT APPROVAL. WORK PERFORMED UNDER SEPARATE PERMIT.
2. CONTRACTOR TO VERIFY WITH WINDOW MANUFACTURER REINFORCING BETWEEN WINDOW UNITS AND PROVIDE ALL REQUIRED REINFORCING.
3. ALL WINDOWS TO HAVE SQUARE BEADS.
4. ALL IMPACT GLASS THICKNESSES SHALL COMPLY WITH PRODUCT APPROVAL.
5. CONTRACTOR TO VERIFY AND COORDINATE WITH WINDOW MANUFACTURER ALL WINDOW ROUGH OPENING REQUIREMENTS PRIOR TO PLACING AN ORDER. CONTACT ARCHITECT IN CASE OF ANY DISCREPANCIES.
6. FINISH ON ALL ALUMINUM DOORS AND WINDOWS SHALL BE BRONZE.
7. PROVIDE STEEL REINFORCING WHERE REQUIRED IN ALL GLASS STOREFRONT AND DOOR SYSTEMS, EXTERIOR AND INTERIOR.
8. BRAKE METAL TO BE INSTALLED AT ALL CORNERS, INTERMEDIATE CONDITIONS AND ADDITIONAL STEEL REINFORCING. FINISH TO MATCH ALUMINUM WINDOWS AND DOORS.
9. STOREFRONT DOORS, WINDOWS AND FIXED GLASS BY E.S. WINDOWS OR EQUAL.
10. ALL GLASS SHALL BE GREEN. CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE GLASS COLOR SAMPLES FOR ARCHITECT'S APPROVAL.
11. EGRESS WINDOWS SHALL BE PROVIDED IN ALL SLEEPING ROOMS BELOW THE FOURTH FLOOR, 2023 FBC 1030.1.
